Juveniles arrested in burglary and robbery investigation

On 07/09/2019 Officers of the Pratt Police Department announced the arrest of two juvenile subjects associated with multiple burglaries, thefts, and weapons violations. The juveniles were detained in a secure facility pending an appearance in the Pratt County District Court. Recovered stolen property includes multiple handguns, knives, car keys, cellular telephones, clothing, and other personal property.

Throughout the course of this investigation, information was developed linking the juveniles to a robbery by firearm occurring on the west side of Pratt and additional charges are pending.

The department commends the hard work of both our patrol and investigative staff for their diligence, persistence and action in identifying and taking these suspects into custody. The safety of our community is a top priority for the department.

Because these subjects are juveniles, no identifying information will be released by this office. Additional information will be released by and through the Pratt County Attorney's Office.

Please remember that all suspects are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
