MISSING PERSON JAMES FLUMMERFELT

On 07/30/2020 at 14:00 Officers of the Pratt Police Department were asked to conduct a welfare check on 79 YOA James E. Flummerfelt at his residence in Pratt. The requester advised that earlier on 07/30/2020 James significant other had been admitted to Pratt Regional Medical Center and then transported to Wesley Medical Center in Wichita. The requestor stated that James should not be driving and she was concerned that he might try to drive to Wichita. She further stated James has not been diagnosed with Dementia however, does have periods where he forgets where he is at or what he is doing and should not be driving. Officers were able to contact James at approximately 14:10 PM and found James to be alert and during questioning determined that James was not going any where. On 07/30/2020 at approximately 15:00 James was observed by a neighbor leaving his residence in a Gold Chevrolet Trailblazer KS Registration plate 399AUK. Both James and the vehicle have been entered into NCIC and a Silver Alert issued. Flummerfelt was found safe and in fair condition on 07/31/2020.
